ITINERARY

- Day 01** **Depart JFK International to Accra, Ghana**
SEP 14 – Fri Arrive at JFK International Airport for check in 3 hours before the flight
- Day 02** **Arrival in Accra Dinner and Traditional Dance**
SEP 15 – Sat Arrive in Accra, Ghana clear immigration and customs and proceed to your hotel
On arrival in Accra, clear immigration and customs and transfer you to your hotel for check in.
Dinner with Cultural entertainment and Dance
Overnight at La Palm Royal Hotel – **(Dinner included)**
- Day 03** **Accra Worship Service**
SEP 16 – Sun Attend a church service, lunch and return to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.
Overnight at La Palm Royal Hotel – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 04** **Accra – City Tour**
SEP 17 – Mon You will depart your hotel for a full day tour of Accra. Nkrumah Memorial, Artists Alliance, DuBois Center, etc. Overnight at La Palm Royal Hotel – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 05** **Accra – Kumasi Craft Villages**
SEP 18 – Tue You will depart **Accra** for Kumasi and visit enroute Ejisu Besease and the craft villages of Ashantis to **Bonwire** where the world famous kente cloth is woven, **Ntonso** which is home to the traditional Adinkra cloth and **Ahwiaa** for woodcarving.
Overnight at Golden Tulip Hotel Kumasi – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 06** **Kumasi Cultural Orientation**
SEP 19 – Wed After breakfast this morning, you will embark on a tour of Kumasi visiting the **Manhyia Palace** where you will see replicas of old kings and royal stools of the Ashantis. You will also visit **King Prempeh II Museum**, **Okomfo Anokye** sword site where a legendry sword is driven into the ground by this famous priest several centuries ago. Further tours will take you to the **Cultural Center** where you will see artists at work
Overnight at Golden Tulip Hotel Kumasi – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 07** **Kumasi – Cape Coast Castle**
SEP 20 – Thu You will depart Kumasi for Elmina with a stop at Assin Manso, the place where the captured Africans took their last bath before being taken to the coast where they were sold into slavery and sent to the Americas. Upon arrival in Elmina you will visit the **Elmina Castle** that was built by the Portuguese. You will be guided through the slave dungeons, the Door of No Return, etc.
Overnight at Coconut Grove – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 08** **Cape Coast Castle – Kakum National Park**
SEP 21 – Fri After breakfast, depart for **Kakum National Park**. You will have the choice between walking the trails with a guide to explore the cultural and medicinal uses of the plants in the forest or for the more adventuresome the canopy walkway will provide a bird's eye view of the forest. Enjoy lunch at Hans Cottage Botel then to **Cape Coast Castle** for a tour.
Overnight at Coconut Grove – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 09** **Depart for Accra**
SEP 22 – Sat After breakfast depart for Accra.
Overnight at La Palm Beach Resort – **(Breakfast & Lunch)**
- Day 10** **Free Day in Accra – Evening Farewell Dinner**
SEP 23 – Sun Day at leisure
Overnight at La Palm Beach Resort – **(Breakfast & Dinner)**
- Day 11** **Depart Accra**
SEP 24 – Mon Today you will transfer to the airport to board your flight to the US. Arrive in NY this same day.
